We build strength, stability and independence through shelter. We empower families to improve the place they call home and build a better tomorrow for their children. When disaster strikes, Habitat is there on the ground, supporting those most affected to rebuild their lives in the aftermath of natural disasters. Since 1976, we've served more than 46 million people.

In Ireland, for nearly 30 years our mission has called thousands of people to action. Building and refurbishment projects have delivered positive and lasting change for individuals and communities in Ireland and around the world.

Habitat changes lives in the belief that everyone has something to give and something to gain from building strong community.

Our programmes engage people of all ages and abilities; through formal and informal education, those needing support for employment, affected by mental health challenges or brain injury, retired people needing new purpose and those within the justice system.

Habitat for Humanity was born on a small farm in deeply segregated southern Georgia, USA, with a deep commitment to peace, justice and equality.
