Easter Hope

Support for Lebanon

As headlines continue to bring stories of desperation, heartbreak and anguish in the Middle East- pray for Habitat's work in Lebanon where war has displaced nearly 1 million people, 20% of the country's entire population.

Give thanks that funds from Ireland are supporting Habitat Lebanon's response, alongside partners, towards early recovery and long-term stability through upgrading collective shelters and providing essential services to those who are most vulnerable. Pray that people will be moved to respond to our emergency appeal which will directly enable those who have been forced to flee. Ask for God's blessing on all those seeking safety and shelter and all those who help.



Speaking out

Praise God for many opportunities to share about Habitat and its impact and how others can join in this mission. Bless all the conversations that happened on stands; after speaking engagements and over a cup of coffee. May these conversations spark new opportunities and connections that can help scale up Habitat's impact both here and across the world. Pray that as we deliver programmes which engage young people in schools and in ReStore we would inspire action for housing, and help build a generation of active citizens.



Cost of living

As people struggle to manage the rising cost of fuel and essentials, providing an opportunity for low-cost home improvement options is vital. Give thanks for donors across Ireland, in communities and in companies, who commit to donate to ReStore.
